

Project Volunteer Opportunities:

Organization Drives – Can be done any time of year

- Sock Drives – Kids, youth and adult socks. Unisex, girls or boys. All types. New. Neutral Colors
- Underwear – Same as above; kids, youth and adult. Boys and girls, men and women. Neutral Colors
- Toiletries – Sample and Travel sizes and Full size of soap, shampoo, conditioner, combs, toothpaste, toothbrushes, floss
 - Either put together as individual packets for homeless youth
 - Or have boxes of each item separated
- Blankets – Especially during winter; fleece blankets
 - No red or blue (gang colors)
- Eats – Grab and Go food items
 - Granola bars, trail mix, nuts, dried fruit, etc.
 - Things that are portable, easy to carry, and don't spoil easily

Workshops

- Teach something – skills or hobbies
 - Knitting, Crochet, Sewing, Quilting, etc.
 - Cooking, Baking, Nutrition, Food Budgeting
 - Applications, Interview Skills, Soft Skills

Adopt a Family Drives – Different Drives throughout the year

Adopt A Home – Spring (March – April)

- Many teens transition into their own spaces during the spring
 - Move in Baskets – towels, cleaning supplies, sheets, blankets (bed in a bag), small cooking appliance (rice cooker, toaster, blender, etc.)

Adopt A Student – Summer/Fall (July – August)

- We hold a backpack and school supplies drive during the month of July to prepare student for back to school in August

Adopt A Family – Winter (October through December)

- Adopt children or families
 - As a group, decide to adopt a child or a family
 - Provide gifts from profile of child or family
 - Value per individual around \$200 per individual
 - Do a Gift Card Drive
- Warehouse help
 - Accept gifts from donors
 - Double and triple check all items in social worker's area is for that social worker
 - Bikes
 - Assemble – on location
 - Pick up – location TBD
 - Help programs deliver to a single location or multiple locations
